The Founders Award celebrates those dedicated to the mission of the Calvin Coolidge Alumni Association (CCAA) and whose work impacts the association and its members. The award brings honor and attention to individual and organizational award recipients. Below are some criteria to consider for potential award recipients. The recipient may or not be a member of CCAA and may be an organization. An individual or organization does not need to meet all of the criteria to be considered for the award. The Founders will be responsible for the selection and presentation of the award.

- Engages the community to implement the mission of CCAA
- Uses knowledge, skills and resources to advance the Coolidge community and the mission of CCAA
- Develops, implements and/or supports school and community programs that serve Coolidge students
- Promotes collaborative community relationships, services and/or programs that engage and involve Coolidge students
- Provides significant career contributions that have had an impact on the needs, rights and well-being of Coolidge students
- Provides vision, inspiration, structure and direction to CCAA and its initiatives that result in the increase of membership and/or association visibility
